Themes & Perspectives

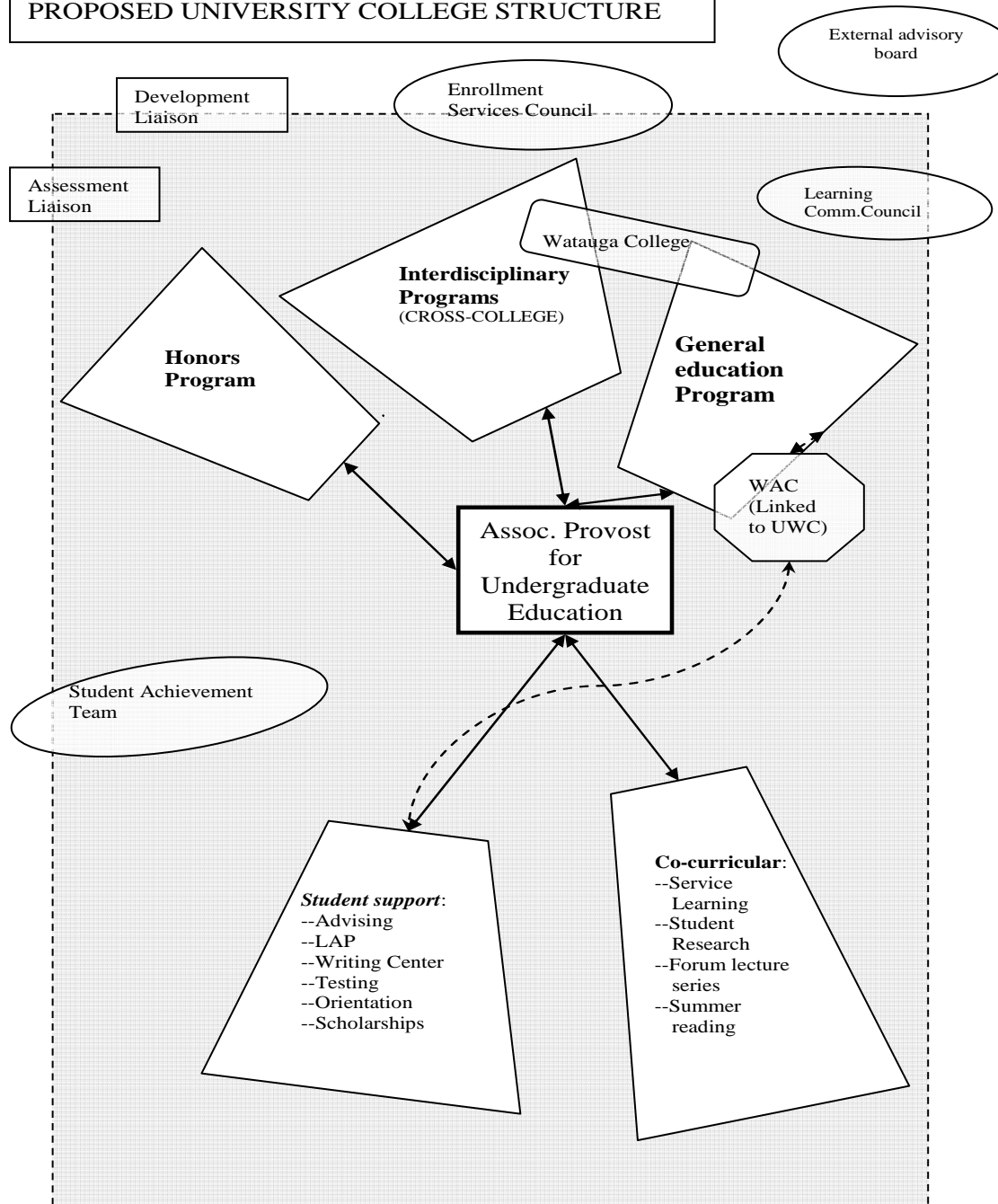
